This process alters the wood's chemical structure, making it more durable, resistant to decay, and less prone to shrinking or warping. Thermowood is the best material for sauna construction, as it has several benefits that make it particularly well-suited for the high heat and humidity conditions typical of saunas.

Enhanced Durability: The heat treatment process makes Thermowood more resistant to mold, fungi, and insects, extending the life of sauna materials.

Stability: Thermowood is less likely to warp, crack, or shrink compared to untreated wood. This is particularly important in saunas, where temperature and humidity levels fluctuate.

Low Maintenance: Because it is more resistant to moisture, Thermowood requires less maintenance than regular wood. It doesn't need as frequent sealing or chemical treatments, making it more eco-friendly.

Sauna Health Benefits: Thermowood's smooth texture and resistance to moisture prevent the growth of harmful bacteria or fungi that could be a concern in high-humidity environments like saunas.

Eco-Friendly: The heat treatment is a natural process that does not involve the use of chemicals, making Thermowood an environmentally friendly option.
